1. What do you want to do? Summarise your project. (Max 200 words)

The Pennypit Family and learning centre provide low cost to free activities for young people and families throughout the year. Over the summer period we would like to

- Host two trips to Blair Drummond Safari Park for our families who are on low income and in the poverty bracket. Families who don't have access to vehicles, who are on occasions isolated and are regular attendees of the pennypit due to the accessibility, low-cost activities and support they receive. Two trips would accommodate all the families we work with, as the bus is a 52 seater and the number of people who use our centre is more than triple this number.
- To provide lunch boxes for the young people and on occasions the parents who require this from out café M&M munchies to prevent the embarrassment of having to pay the high costs of food while at the park.
- Making positive memories for families that simply can't afford to take their children away on holidays due to their personal restraints.

The Pennypit over the last year has grown and developed into local hub of support for families though the PSG, and beyond. We offer affordable and friendly environment to use for all needs within the community. This for us shows the increasing need for increased support of the local families that don't uses existing services due to being just over the official support need bracket and are trying to maintain the difficulties and stress of the financial restraints independently.

The difference we have made to date is having the opportunity to work with families, lone parents, young parents and kinship carers who are struggling in various ways. We signpost to services that can give additional support and support them to access them. The difference we have seen evidently from the increasing numbers and usage within our centre.

We have independently to date funded these events through the management committee directly and we fundraise to the best we can to keep out costs low to minimum. We work in connection with M&M Munchies our resident café who is fantastic by supporting our vision by offering kids eat free over the summer.

We have fantastic organisations in Prestonpans that do brilliant work and support. There is a growing need in our ever-growing community to have a space that they feel welcome and able to use for support over the school hoildays. The families have relationships with the staff and management committee who deliver classes. We feel we can deliver these activities confidently and build upon the relationships we have to support local people to feel more part of the community.
